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# OVERVIEW Decked Out Detroit Summer Activations 2023

## Activations

The Monroe St. Midway will be activated with outdoor recreation and leisure activities beginning May 17th through September 24th. Concepts will include:

- Rocket Mortgage Sports Zone
- Rollout Detroit Roller Rink
- Mini golf
- Concessions
- Art installations by local Detroit artists
- · Programming initiatives that work in conjunction with, not in competition of DDP's programming

This activation is pending approval by the City of Detroit Downtown Development Authority and will heavily promote all applicable City of Detroit and State of Michigan COVID-19 guidelines to help ensure the safest experience for visitors.

In addition to the Midway, we would like to enhance the downtown shopping experience with arts and cultural programming in Parkers Alley, as well as on the following sidewalks: Woodward Avenue, Library Street, Farmer Street, and Monroe Street. Programming schedule to be determined.

## Midway Site Hours of Operation

The site will be a hub for community play and relaxation, open to the public, with additional recreational leagues organized through our partners at Come Play Detroit.

### Health & Safety

The health and safety of Monroe Site guests and service providers are at the forefront of discussion in the development of this project. We plan to implement the following measures to allow for the safest experience for all attendees:

- We will follow and enforce all applicable City of Detroit and State of Michigan health and safety guidelines through signage and on-site operational team members
- Cleaning measures will be implemented to frequently clean restrooms and touch-point surfaces, including but not limited to wiping down surfaces multiple times each operating day and cleaning any games, touch screens or credit card machines
- Posted signage with rules including but not limited to prohibiting all smoking, drugs, weapons,
   and hazardous materials + behavior

### Security

Rock Security is diligently working to determine the level of coverage and service provider(s) for the Decked Out Detroit Activations, including support from Michigan State Police and Detroit Police Department. The Midway entrances will be monitored; during non-event hours the site will be completely fenced off to the public, including the Farmer Street, Monroe Street, and Cadillac Square entrances/exits.

### Trash, Sanitation & Landscaping

We will have consistent and reliable cleaning of all spaces. Cleaning and sanitation during hours of operations will be supported by The Professional Group. At the Monroe Street Midway, we will have (1) 4-yard dumpster and (1) 4-yard recycling receptacle placed on the closed portion of Farmer Street. The dumpster will be serviced regularly by our provider Dinverno Group, LLC. Restroom trailers are provided and serviced by United Rentals.

## Generators and Power:

In 2021, efforts were officially completed with DTE to reconnect permanent power to the Monroe Site, which we plan to continue utilizing to support all facets of the activation this season. Any public cables crossing public traffic will be covered with cable ramps.



# Zone 1

The Rollout Detroit area will return for roller skating. We will be working with RollerCade, our desired operator, to finalize our operations plan.

This plan will have an emphasis on guest safety and will include:

- Cleaning and sanitation will happen for all touch-point surfaces multiple times each day
- Electronic sign-ups will be encouraged, all in person check-ins will happen with limited contact
- Staff will wear gloves where necessary
- Capacity limits will be enforced in line with State and City ordinances
- Time limits will be enforced to allow for less queueing and waiting
- Clear signage will be on-site outlining both the general rules of Rollout Detroit as well as any
- Bumper cars will be sanitized between each use
- Helmets will be available upon request free of charge. These will be sanitized between each use

# Zone 2

Zone 2 will include a large open lawn to provide park space for attendants, including swings and seesaws. This zone will also include space for a concession stand & two (2) food trucks with access to the site via Farmer Street; ARM MI will act as food and beverage operator.

This plan will have an emphasis on guest safety and will include:

- Cleaning and sanitation for all touch-point surfaces multiple times each day
- · Staff will wear gloves if necessary
- Both cash and electronic forms of payment will be accepted
- Clear signage will be on-site outlining both the general rules of the space as well as the COVID safety rules in accordance with current local and state guidelines.

# ZONE 3

Mini golf will return for the summer and shade will be provided in this space.

# Michigan State Police:

- Currently scheduled Secondary MSP will be leveraged to assist with the overall safety and security of the event and its immediate surroundings
- This includes but is not limited to patrolling and keeping foot traffic moving, responding to patrons not adhering to the rules and regulations, responding to non-patrons loitering/lingering along perimeter of site

**Security Provider:** City Shield; there will be Officers and a Supervisor on site during operating hours. Will also have an on-site Security Officer in a vehicle.

**Evacuations**: In the event that an emergency arises, and evacuation of the Rocket Mortgage Sports Zone is required:

- The Rocket Mortgage Sports Zone Supervisor or Local Authorities shall authorize and activate the evacuation plan, call 911, and then notify the Rock Security Command Center (RSCC).
- Staff and Security will be notified via radio and occupants will be notified via the loudspeaker to safely evacuate the Rocket Mortgage Sports Zone.
- Staff and Security will begin directing occupants to use the safest exit access to the nearest emergency exit (as identified in the site map below).
- All emergency exits will discharge into a safe public space, where occupants will continue to move away from the threat.



# Monroe Street Midway Emergency Procedure Updates for the 2023 Jazz Festival

The 2023 **Detroit Jazz Festival** will take place in the downtown areas of Campus Martius Park, Cadillac Square, and Hart Plaza between **September 2<sup>nd</sup> – 5<sup>th</sup>, 2022**. During this time, the Monroe Street Midway will be implementing a temporary evacuation plan, to ensure the safety and security of all Midway guests/staff and Jazz Festival spectators.

# **Evacuation Plan**


If an emergency arises, and an evacuation of the Monroe Street Midway is required:

- 1. The Onsite Manager or Local Authorities shall authorize and activate the evacuation plan, call 911, and then notify the Rock Security Command Center (RSCC) at 313-373-3333.
- 2. If an emergency response vehicle is required to enter the Monroe Street Midway, the onsite manager should direct them to enter via the **Monroe/Farmer** vehicle access control point.
- 3. Staff and Security will be notified via radio and occupants will be notified via the loudspeaker to safely evacuate the Rocket Mortgage Sports Zone.
- 4. Staff and Security will begin directing occupants to use the safest exit access to the nearest emergency exit (as identified in the site map).
- 5. A Security Officer should stage at the corner of **Farmer/Bates** and direct the flow of evacuees towards **Randolph Street**, to avoid the masses evacuating directly into the Jazz Festival.
- 6. All emergency exits will discharge into a safe public space, where occupants will continue to move away from the threat.
- 7. Staff will quickly and safely secure equipment and cash before evacuating the site (if safe to do so).
- 8. Security will safely evacuate the site after conducting a sweep of the site (if safe to do so) and all guests have safely evacuated.

**Note:** The Midway will be streaming Jazz Festival audio at the site during the event, but the Midway's mic will still be available for emergency PA usage, if emergency messages to Midway guests are required. When making emergency alerts, please state "Monroe Street Midway" before all alerts so that it is not confused with the Jazz Festival alerts.
